Are you ransomware-aware?

In our recent survey* of more than 3,000 people in the U.S. and Canada, we learned that many are unaware of ransomware or how to defend against it.



...said they would not pay the ransom fee and just risk losing their files, and 15% said they would pay and take the chance that they may not ever get their files back.



...of people did not know if the internet security/antivirus they were using helped protect them from ransomware.

...of respondents NEVER back up their files. Those in the youngest age bracket (18-24) were the most likely age group to never back up files (35%).



.....of people surveyed said they DID NOT KNOW what ransomware was. Younger people (18-24) were the most likely not to know (34%) vs. just 25% of those 65+.
