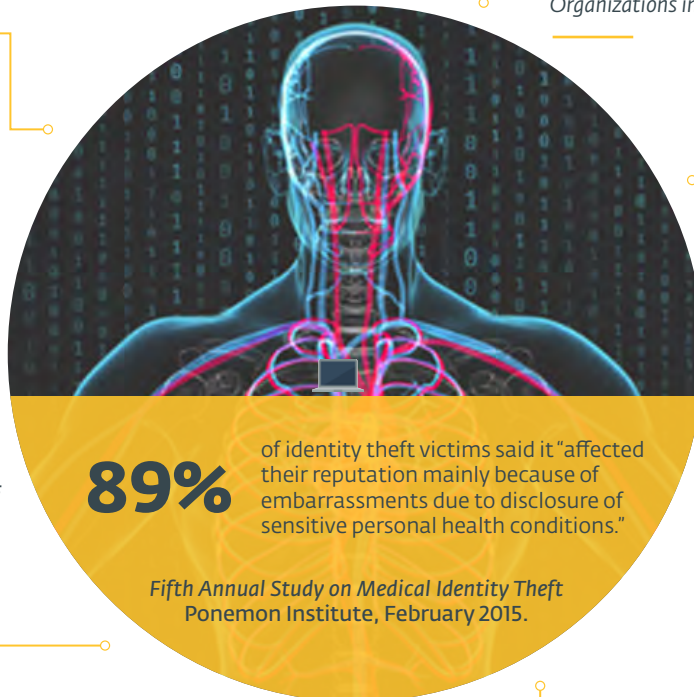
4 out of 5 healthcare organizations believe the most lucrative information for hackers is patient medical records.
